Whether an applicant is an experienced tradesperson seeking Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), looking for flexible delivery modes, or simply wanting to upskill, we offer a wide range of courses to support their career progression.

Overseas Qualified Tradespeople

Upon successfully obtaining an Offshore Technical Skills Record (OTSR), overseas-qualified HVAC mechanics or electricians can complete our NAT Gap Training programs to achieve their Australian qualification.

STEP BY STEP: INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

ENROLMENT STEPS

- Get in touch with your preferred student agency, they will assist submitting your application and documents through our website.
- Once you have submitted all your documents, our team will schedule an interview and issue a Letter of Offer.
- Whenever the deposit payment has been submitted, you will receive a Confirmation of Enrolment which can be used to submit your visa application.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

International students must meet visa, financial (fees/relevant costs) and English language proficiency requirements (IELTS 6.0 or equivalent). Additional documents will be asked through the application such as a record of the last 12 years of studies, a resume and a Genuine Student statement.

STUDENT OBLIGATIONS

Throughout the course, students must meet the minimum attendance and academic requirements in accordance with the conditions of the Subclass 500 Student Visa. In addition, a Workplace Learning Component must be completed alongside the relevant units of competency.

FINAL OUTCOME UPON COMPLETION

Upon completing your Certificate III in Electrotechnology Electrician or Air Conditioning and Refrigeration, you will have met the main requisite to obtain a trade license. Occupations such as Electrician (ANZSCO 341111) and Air Conditioning & Refrigeration Mechanic (ANZSCO 342111) are included on the Australian Skilled Occupation List, reflecting ongoing industry demand nationwide.

QUALITY TRAINING

Our training is designed to add real value to your career. Whether you are new to the industry or already experienced, you will graduate with strong practical skills, hands-on experience, and industry-relevant knowledge.

Student Agencies

- Australia's visa application process can be complex. To support students, we work with a network of over 100 partners who can assist with the application process and answer any questions at no additional cost.

Safety First

- Our courses are delivered in accordance with AS/NZS 3000 (the Wiring Rules), the electrical installation standard used in Australia and New Zealand. This ensures students gain the knowledge and skills required to work safely and in compliance with industry regulations.

Career Pathways

- Our main qualification exceeds 100 study weeks and is aligned with occupations on the Medium and Long-term Strategic Skills List (MLTSSL). This may support eligibility for the Temporary Graduate visa (subclass 485) Post-Vocational Education Work stream. Students should consult a registered migration agent to explore their individual pathway.
